## *The next census is on 27 March 2011*



Every ten years, the census provides an accurate snapshot of the country's population, informing important decisions and policies. Hammersmith and Fulham also relies on census population statistics to get the government funding it needs for public services. How much it gets is directly related to the number and characteristics of the people the census says live in the area. So even if the census were to end up just a few households short, or miss some important sections of the community, it could make a very real difference to people's lives. The census needs to include everyone, everywhere – and that's why everyone has to take part.

### **You can help make it a success by informing your local communities in H & F.**

The Office for National Statistics and the London Borough of Hammersmith and Fulham are working together between now and March 2011 to promote the census to local people.
