Polo in the Park, Hurlingham

The Event and Location

Our inaugural London event at The Hurlingham Club in June 2009 was a resounding success with a sell out audience of just over 25,000 and tv coverage on ITV, Sky, CNN and CNBC. The combination of a glamorous sport at a stunning central London location has meant that 'Polo in the Park' has immediately established itself on the season's calendar and is already proving to be THE event to attend in 2010.



The Hurlingham Club is situated on the North Bank of the River Thames in Fulham, London SW6 and is a private members club set within its own 42 acres of stunning grounds. Polo was first played at the Club in 1874 and from then on the name 'Hurlingham' was synonymous with polo for a further 65 years. It became the undisputed home of the sport and hosted the 1908 Olympics Polo final, when England won the gold medal, and it also hosted the annual Westchester Cup match between England and the USA from 1910 to 1939. With the outbreak of the Second World War, the Club acted as a base for an anti-aircraft battery and a barrage balloon unit and the main polo ground was turned into allotments for growing vegetables.



In 2008 World Polo Limited signed an exclusive deal to reinstate the grounds at Hurlingham Park and bring polo back to its British roots. The magnificent game is now being revived and lives on again at the real home of the sport, The Hurlingham Club.

The World Polo Series™ is a new concept to the sport and the 'Polo in the Park' tournaments that form the Series will be played in major cities all over the globe. The Series has also introduced a number of rule changes to the traditional game improving it as a spectator sport making it faster flowing and grittier. In 2010, 'Polo in the Park' at Hurlingham will host a total of 8 international teams (double the number that played at the 2009 tournament) over a full 3 days culminating on Sunday 6th June with the final and the presentation of The World Polo Series Trophy.
